


Root-Fifth: "VERTICLE LINE"




What do you do if you are playing on the E string, or want a higher tone?


Root-Fifth Alternate: SIDEWAYS "L"



The tone of the fifth in this shape is lower than the root note, and in the "L shape," the fifth note tone is higher than the root note.

**Which string your root note is on will determine which 5th shape you use, as well as what sound you are trying to create.
